TRANSPORTATION

The parking lot should be entered through the Third Street entrance. As you exit the lower parking lot turn left into the drive through. Traffic is one way down the drive toward Lexington Avenue. Yourchild must be let out and picked up at the side door. Children should not arrive at preschool before 7:30a.m.for Morning Glory or 8:40 am for Preschool. A teacher will greet the children at the door from 8:40 -9:00 a.m. If your child is late please park and walk your child to the preschool. Otherwise for the safety of your child please drive through and let a teacher assist your child from the car.

During dismissal, the teachers will have the children assembled in the hall so that you will not need to leave your car. We ask you to place a numbered sign on your car's rear view mirror so that we may recognize your car during dismissal. To ensure the safety of the children and speed this process, please drive through to pick up your child at the end of the day. <u>Please do not walk to the door.</u>

State licensing regulations require that we have a list of people who are approved to pick up your child. Please send a written note if your child's normal transportation arrangements change for the day. If an unexpected need arises during the day for someone else to pick up your child, you may call 859-319-0422 All adults picking up your child should have your car tag or a photo ID to identify themselves.

LIBRARY

We will use the services of the Public Library twice a month. Our 4 and 5 year olds will walk to the Library, weather permitting. For our 3 year olds the librarian, Mrs. Libby McWhorter will be coming to the preschool.

LICENSING

Lexington Avenue Baptist Church Preschool is licensed by the Cabinet for Health Services, Commonwealth of Kentucky. It meets all the state and county fire and health requirements. All classroom teachers in the Lexington Avenue Baptist Church Preschool program are certified in CPR, First Aid and the use of a AED.

NUTRITIOUS SNACKS

The children will have a nutritious mid-morning snack each day. If your child has a food allergy please inform the staff in writing so that we will be aware of this when requesting snacks. <u>LABC</u>

is a nut free school.

Snack time is a learning and sharing experience. We ask that you send your child's favorite nutritious snack to his/her class once a month. We will be sending more information and a schedule at orientation. We also celebrate birthdays and holidays. You are welcome to provide a special treat for your child's birthday and sign up for a special party during the year.

CLOTHING SUGGESTIONS

Children are most comfortable in machine-washable clothing

that does not restrict movement. They like clothing with fasteners that they can manipulate themselves. Our program emphasizes active participation. *For the safety of your child, all students should wear tennis shoes to school each day.*

Please provide a Ziploc bag with a change of clothes for your child. Make sure it and all clothing is labeled with you child's name.

ILLNESS AND MEDICATION

Your child's health is of major importance to us. A child who is ill is not functioning at his/her optimum level and may be contagious to other children. For the benefit of your child, it is best to keep him/her home for one day after he has had a fever. Please notify our staff if your child has been exposed to a communicable disease. Parents of all children who have been exposed will be notified so that they may consult with their physician. Due to the short duration of our program, we will not be able to administer medications to your child. Please administer prior to leaving home if your child is currently taking some type of medication.

We are required by the Commonwealth of Kentucky to have immunization certificates on file for each child enrolled in our program. Please secure this form from your doctor or the health

department and return it to us at the beginning of the school year.

TOYS

We ask that children not bring personal toys to school, but we do welcome good books, music, and nature items that can be shared. Please label items with your child's name.

DISCIPLINE

We practice a positive proactive discipline policy at LABC. We

teach clear expectations and practice rules and procedures to insure a safe and secure environment. Discipline will be constructive in nature including methods of diversion, separation of child from the situation, praise for appropriate behavior or time out as appropriate for the age of the child.

CURRICULUM INFORMATION Our program lays the foundation for a positive learning experience throughout your child's life. Our curriculum provides ongoing thematic units throughout the year. They provide opportunities to explore and discover new things about the world. They are designed to progress as your child's skills develop. Academic skills are incorporated into each theme. We also include activities with letters and numbers each day. Wewelcomeyourparticipation in our program and encourage you to allow your child to share with his/herfriends at Preschool. Children are encouraged to bring books, pictures, CDs/tapes, and other materials related to the units as they are being covered.




The following is a copy of the daily schedule for the four year old classes. The three year olds and the five year olds follow a similar
